

Progress on New Church

Despite the impacts of the pandemic and general slowdown of activities, through the grace of God, we have been able to make great progress on the new church project. The overall site plan has matured significantly following consultation from the Region of Halton on the future expansion of Steeles Avenue. Additionally, in July, we completed a preliminary review with the Town of Milton for the overall concept, providing internal layout schematics, and showcasing a design that balances between Coptic tradition and a modern look that is fit for a growing and flourishing community in Milton. Furthermore, we have commenced work with a number of engineering consulting firms to complete the balance of studies required by the Town.

We hope to share more details of the project at the next edition of Blessings, and remain confident in God's love towards His church, through the supplications of the saints and the prayers of the faithful.
